Parking:

A parking area for **trailers with boats and towing vehicles** will be available on the Rue de Courseulles from 8 a.m. It is the section of road from the Higher Ferry south on the Dartmouth riverside. It will also be used for the WEARA crews on Thursday, 29th August, 2024. There should be room for everyone.

Launching:

The public slip for launching is next to the Higher Ferry slip. Allow plenty of time for launching as the slip is busy with other craft launching/recovering. Additionally, boats will have to row down river for the start.

Personal vehicles:

Personal vehicles will have to use the Park & Ride. There will be limited bookable parking on Coronation Park. As soon as booking details are available I will forward.

Course:

The chart is attached and also available on the Regatta web site - www.dartmouthregatta.co.uk Start and finish will be between the Royal Dart Yacht Club, Kingswear and Bayards Cove (Dartmouth side).

The Long course races start off the Royal Dart Yacht Club, row out of the river, turn around the Mewstone, and return to the river to finish off the Royal Dart Yacht Club.

Short course races start off the Royal Dart Yacht Club, row out of the river, turn around the Castle Ledge Buoy, and return to the river to finish off the Royal Dart Yacht Club.

Briefing:

Ray Mallett, the start/finish official, will make the briefing to club captains at 10.00 a.m. at the top of the slipway. We propose to use marine radio channel 71 but Ray will confirm on the day.
