

## **Regatta 175 Celebration Event**

### **Terms and conditions**

1. Photographic ID (either passport or driving licence) must be presented when entering the Britannia Royal Naval College (BRNC) and carried at all times during the event. The ID must match the name on the ticket. Guests may be subject to a bag search. The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta, Britannia Royal Naval College and Fresh Security have the right to refuse admission.
2. Tickets are available to purchase from Billetto.co.uk only. These will be e-tickets, which will be emailed to you on completion of purchase. Only tickets sold by our provider are valid for admission. Once purchased, tickets cannot be resold or refunded. Reselling a ticket makes it void and the ticketholder will be refused entry. Tickets may only be transferred via the Transfer Ticket option on the Billetto website up to 48 hours prior to the event.
3. Over 18's only will be permitted entry to the event.
4. The event will start at 18.00pm and finish at 22.00pm. All guests must have left the BRNC grounds via the main gates by 22.30pm.
5. Dress code is cocktail dresses, jacket & tie/ lounge suits or military uniform.
6. There will be a reasonably priced and varied licensed bar at the event. Therefore you will not be permitted to bring your own alcohol to the event. A glass of sparkling wine/prosecco on arrival is included with the ticket. To ensure the responsible sale of alcohol we will be operating 'Challenge 25'. Therefore if you are lucky enough to look under 25 please be prepared to show photographic proof of age. The only acceptable forms of identification will be a UK/EU Driving License, a passport or a photocard bearing the PASS hologram.
7. The bar company has the right to refuse the sale of alcohol to anyone they consider intoxicated, in accordance with UK law.
8. Due to the size and sensitive nature of the site (and to protect our precious environment) guests will be presented with a drinking vessel on arrival. This

will need to be returned to the bar each time in exchange for your next drink. Your help with this on the evening will be much appreciated.

9. There will be no access to the BRNC building, with the exception of the main southerly doors to access the toilet facilities, unless in the event of bad weather, when additional access will be permitted as directed by the Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta and the BRNC.
10. All guests must keep to the parade ground and walkways to the main gate, or as directed by BRNC security, The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta or Fresh Security. As a courtesy, please keep off the grass whilst in the BRNC.
11. The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta does not accept responsibility for accident, injury, or loss suffered while attending the event, when signage, instructions and requests from the Regatta, BRNC security and Fresh Security have been ignored and negligence has been shown.
12. The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta, BRNC security and Fresh security have the right to remove guests at any time during the event.
13. No vehicles will be permitted to enter BRNC, with the exception of guests with disabilities, who need to email [Regatta175celebration@gmail.com](mailto:Regatta175celebration@gmail.com) at least 48 hours before the event, to gain access. Only taxi companies approved by the BRNC will be able to enter the site (details of these companies can be obtained through contacting the above email address).
14. The Park and Ride bus runs into town until c7pm. After 7pm, the number 90 bus runs from Victoria Road (next to the Spar) to the Park and Ride car park (bus ticket included with a valid Park and Ride ticket). Taxis may be available from outside Flavel Arts Centre.
15. There will be no transportation provided to guests within the BRNC. Guests will be expected to walk up to the parade ground, with the exception of guests with valid disability requirements.
16. Social Media – Users are trusted to be responsible, but Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta may report, remove or request the removal of any content that

it considers unlawful, or which it deems inappropriate, including but not limited to:

- Obscene, offensive, hateful or inflammatory comments.
- Threatening or abusive content.
- Content showing harmful or dangerous acts.
- Sexually explicit content.
- Violent or graphic content.
