Short course: Starts in the Bight, row out of the river, turn around the Castle Ledge Buoy, and return to the river to finish in the Bight.

Novice Race: The 2000 metre course for the Novice race will start just below the Higher Ferry, row down river to almost the Lower Ferry, turn a buoy and back to the start line to finish.
